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## **MATERNAL IMMUNIZATION OVERVIEW**

Program Name: Maternal Vulnerable Population Partnership

**CDC Division/Center:** CDC National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases (NCIRD)

**Program Goal:** Increase Tdap, influenza, COVID-19, and RSV immunization rates among pregnant people by collaborating with prenatal care clinician organizations to improve communication, disseminate educational resources, and develop an infrastructure to advance maternal immunization.

#### BACKGROUND



How and when are individuals talking to their providers about the Tdap, flu, and COVID-19 vaccines

Why may pregnant individuals either receive or decline the Tdap, flu, and COVID-19 vaccines?

What information sources do pregnant individuals rely on to provide information about vaccines?

How has the COVID-19 vaccine influenced how pregnant individuals feel about getting the flu or Tdap in pregnancy?



#### **METHODOLOGY**



#### Two Online Text-Based Focus Groups

A total of 63 individuals participated in the focus groups:

- Group 1: Those experiencing their first pregnancy
- Group 2: Those not experiencing pregnancy for the first time

#### Survey

A total of 900 individuals participated in the survey.


To qualify for participation, all focus group and survey participants must have been:

- Currently pregnant OR
- Planning to be pregnant (within the next 12 months) OR •
- Recently pregnant (within the last 6 months)


## **VACCINE RECOMMENDATIONS**

Please rank the top 3 reasons for getting a flu/Tdap/COVID-19 vaccine during pregnancy.




The most important reason was keeping the baby safe both during and after pregnancy. My doctor explained that newborns aren't able to get the flu vaccine several months after birth, so it was critical to keeping the baby safe during this time.






#### WHERE RESPONDENTS RECEIVED THEIR VACCINES




For each of the following, where did you receive your vaccine?







#### TOP REASONS FOR NOT RECEIVING VACCINES

I have never had whooping cough. My doctor and I have not talked about this particular vaccine.

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- Experienced parent, trying to get pregnant, White (non-Hispanic)

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I don't think it's necessary because the flu is not very serious.

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- Experienced parent, trying to get pregnant, Hispanic/Latino

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I worry about long term effects [of the COVID-19 vaccine] and how quickly they came out with it. I've had family members experience some negative effects and worry about how that can impact me and my baby.




